

## DINING AT BRUTON

All meals are taken in the School Dining Hall which is a modern, relaxed setting. Boarders take breakfast and supper in the Dining Hall and they are joined by day students for lunch.

Preparatory School pupils start lunch at 12.15pm and they are followed by the Senior School at 1.00pm. Sixth Form students can dine anytime after 12.30pm. A self-service system is operated in the dining hall with the girls having the choice of hot or cold meals.

The wide variety of meals takes into consideration the need for healthy eating as well as catering for vegetarians and girls suffering from food allergies. All girls are also provided with a snack at morning break and an afternoon snack is provided for all boarders and any day girls staying for after-school activities.
